Objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To expand students' vocabulary both general and subject specific; 2. To teach analytical reading skills through exposure to a wider range of text types than in the Prep. Program's main courses; 3. To improve learners' ability to express opinions; 4. To give learners an opportunity to write creatively; 5. To encourage students to read more and follow their interests in a more self-directed manner.
